



On **2nd August 2025**, **Saturday**, an insightful and well-organized seminar on **Parenting and Child Development** was conducted in the school auditorium – Atmiya Dham. The event witnessed enthusiastic participation from parents from class three to five, who gathered to understand the evolving challenges and responsibilities of modern-day parenting.

The event began at 8:30 a.m. with the lighting of the lamp by Principal Sir, Shilpa Mam and Parents. This was followed by a Presentation by Principal Sir. Below points were discussed in detail by Principal Sir:

The Presentation began with a focus on the **definition and process of parenting**. As per the presentation, parenting was defined as "the process or experience provided to a child to build self-esteem, self-worth and a host of traits essential for becoming a good human being." The session emphasized that parenting supports and promotes the **physical**, **emotional**, **social**, **intellectual**, and spiritual development of a child from infancy to adulthood.

A significant highlight of the Presentation was the explanation of the **Four Major Parenting Styles**:

- Authoritative Balanced parenting with firm rules and expectations, combined with warmth, understanding, and open communication.
- **Authoritarian** High expectations with strict rules and less warmth, usually emphasizing obedience and discipline.
- **Permissive** Lenient parenting with few demands; parents are nurturing but tend to avoid setting boundaries.
- Neglectful Uninvolved and indifferent parenting, providing little guidance, nurturing, or attention.

These parenting styles were categorized based on levels of **responsiveness and demanding-ness**, helping parents reflect on their approach and its impact on children's overall behavior and development.

The seminar also included a session based on the **New Education Policy 2020**, which states:

"The purpose of the education system is to develop good human beings capable of rational thought and action, possessing compassion and empathy, courage and resilience, scientific temper and creative imagination, with sound ethical moorings and values."

A thought-provoking segment highlighted the **key health-related concerns of modern parents**. According to the data presented, parents expressed worry over issues like:

Bullying and Cyberbullying (34%), Personal Safety (31%) Screen Time (29%), Drug and Alcohol Use (27%) Not Enough Exercise (23%), Depression (22%) Unhealthy Eating (22%), Motor Vehicle Accidents (23%)



These concerns underline the growing complexities children face in today's fast-paced, tech-driven world.



Parents today are highly concerned about issues like cyberbullying (34%), internet safety (30%), stress (28%), and unhealthy habits, highlighting the urgent need for emotional support, digital safety, and health awareness in parenting. These issues were also discussed in detail.

Homework should be age-appropriate, engaging, and aligned with CBSE guidelines—focusing on reinforcing classroom learning without causing stress or excessive burden on students.

The Presentation concluded with a reminder that raising emotionally healthy and ethical individuals requires consistent support from both parents and educators. Attendees left the venue more aware, reflective, and motivated to apply what they had learned in their daily parenting practices.

This was followed by fun filled interactive games organized for parents to encourage active participation, strengthen parent-child bonding, and create a joyful learning environment. Parents thoroughly enjoyed these activities, which brought fun and engagement to the session.

Lastly, feedback from parents - the parents expressed heartfelt appreciation for the seminar, calling it insightful, practical, and much needed in today's fast-paced world. They found the sessions on parenting styles, emotional bonding, and digital safety particularly helpful. Many parents shared that the seminar gave them a fresh perspective on how to better understand and support their children.

The teachers were highly praised for their dedication, warmth, and thoughtful planning of the seminar. Their efforts in creating a welcoming environment and presenting complex topics in an easy-to-understand manner were deeply appreciated by the parents. Their commitment to nurturing not just students but also supporting parents in the learning journey was evident throughout the event.

Overall, the feedback was overwhelmingly positive, with requests for more such sessions in the future.

The workshop commenced promptly with an inaugural session, followed by a series of interactive and informative sessions throughout the day.

#### **Key Takeaways:**

- Calculating BMR helps to determine what number of calories students should be eating in order to maintain the weight, lose weight or even gain weight and to determine their body weight status, classifying students as underweight, normal, overweight or obese.
- Understands the role of Dopamine, Serotonin in cognition and balance of Dopamine Vs Serotonin especially important for teenagers to acting quickly for rewards and thinking for long term outcomes and the effect of obesity on teenage brain.

Session 2: "Enhanced Competencies and 21st Century Skills" was led by Dr. Rajnikant Makwana from the Department of Physics. The nuclear energy workshop provided a comprehensive overview of the current state of nuclear energy and its potential for future growth. The workshop covered various topics, including introduction of scientist according to first invention of electrons, different rays such as X-ray, Gamma ray etc. Generation wise upgradation of Nuclear power plant, Renewable energy sources, Indias's three stage nuclear power plant programmed, Nuclear power generation in India, Working principle of nuclear batteries, Advantage of fusion over fission, Recent innovations related nuclear power plant, Safety and environment impact.

#### **Key Takeaways:**

- Nuclear batteries are a powerful solution for nice energy needs because in fusion the fuel is hydrogen isotopes deuterium and tritium which are easily available. Decades of safe and reliable performance
- Innovation is making nuclear power plant smaller, safer and more efficient for example SMR.

The expert-led discussion on STEM education was a valuable experience for teachers, providing them with insights and strategies to enhance their teaching practices. The event demonstrated the school's commitment to innovative education and teacher development.
