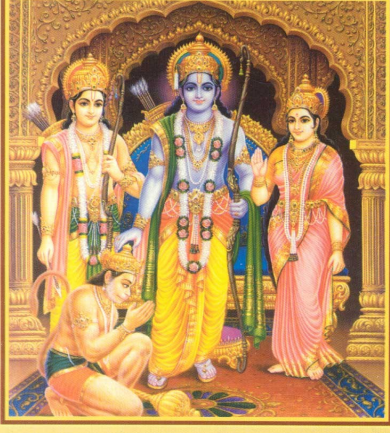

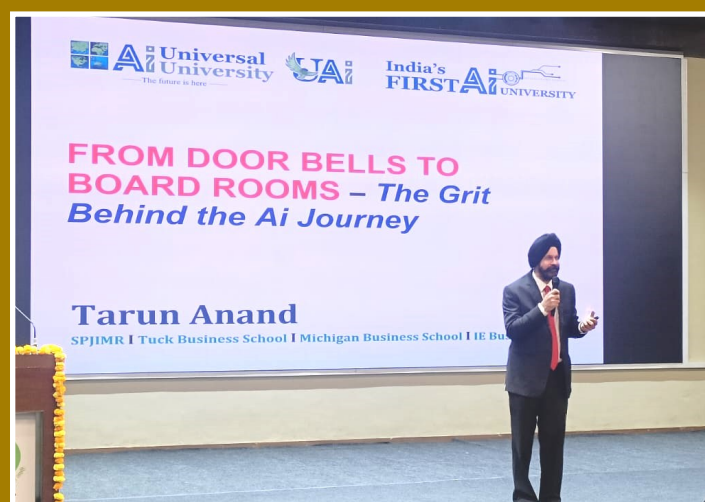


2. KEYNOTE SESSIONS & LEADERSHIP INSIGHTS

The festival was anchored by sessions from industry titans who provided a "behind-the-scenes" look at what it takes to succeed in the modern global economy

* Prof. Pradyumna Vyas (IIT Bombay Alumnus): With a distinguished career spanning 36 years in design education—including his tenure as the Director of NID—Prof. Vyas delivered a masterclass on Design Thinking. He taught that innovation is not just about complexity; it is about observing human struggles and designing intuitive solutions. His three decades of experience highlighted that empathy is the core of any successful product.

* Mr. Tarun Anand (Chancellor, Universal AI University): A world-renowned TEDx speaker, Mr. Anand shared his "Grit Journey." His most impactful takeaway was a mantra that resonated with every student present: "Smashing deadlines beats everybody." He emphasized that in a world of high-speed Artificial Intelligence, those who execute with discipline and speed are the ones who lead.



3. NATIONAL REPRESENTATION

The presence of the highest-ranking officials in the Indian education system underscored the event's importance. It was addressed by:

- * Shri Rahul Singh (IAS): Chairman of CBSE.
- * Dr. Sunil Shukla: Director General of EDII .
- * Dr. Biswajit Saha: Director (Skill Education), CBSE .

Their collective presence sent a clear message: the future of India lies in skill-based education and moving beyond traditional rote learning to solve national challenges.



4. TECHNICAL EXHIBITION & INNOVATION

One standout project featured a revolutionary communication device designed to convert voice into Braille and Braille into voice across multiple languages. This exposure was a deeply transformative experience. Observing peers who displayed remarkable dedication towards their craft highlighted the vast possibilities in AI, Entrepreneurship, and Design. The innovative projects showcased were the result of consistent hard work and a refusal to give up. 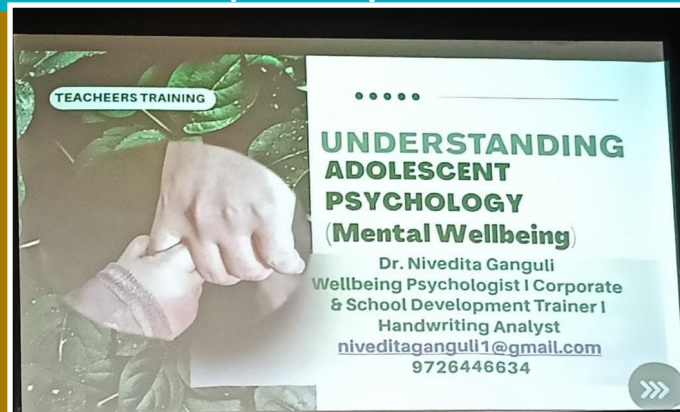

- Enhanced stage confidence



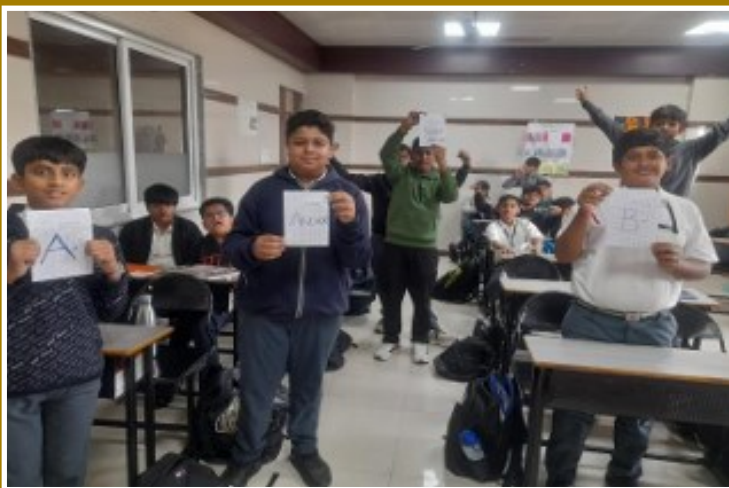
Standard VIII – English Activities
