



Editorial

Jal Jhilani Ekadashi Celebration

Jal Jhilani Ekadashi, also known as *Parivartini Ekadashi* or *Dol Gyaras*, is a spiritually rich Hindu festival celebrated on the 11th day (Ekadashi) of the bright fortnight in the month of Bhadrapada (August–September). Marks the symbolic turning of Lord Vishnu in His cosmic sleep (*Yog Nidra*), which began on Devshayani Ekadashi. Associated with Lord Vishnu's *Vaman Avatar* and also with Mother Yashoda washing Lord Krishna's clothes, symbolizing divine purification. Devotees observe a *Nirjala* (waterless) fast, believed to bring spiritual merit and blessings.

Teachers' Day

We celebrated Teachers' Day to honour the hard work and dedication of our educators. Students presented speeches, performed dances and gave handmade cards to show their appreciation. 
Navratri Celebration


The celebration concluded with an air of devotion, unity and joy, giving students an opportunity to connect with rich cultural and spiritual traditions.

Venue: Bharatiya Vidya Bhavans School, Vadodara









Workshop focused on specific tools for different kind of uses or requirements for educators.

Everyone should use AI tools with accountability and responsibility. AI should be used as a supportive tool, not a replacement. Overall the workshop was well-organized, impactful, and has motivated participants to apply the knowledge and skills gained their respective fields.
