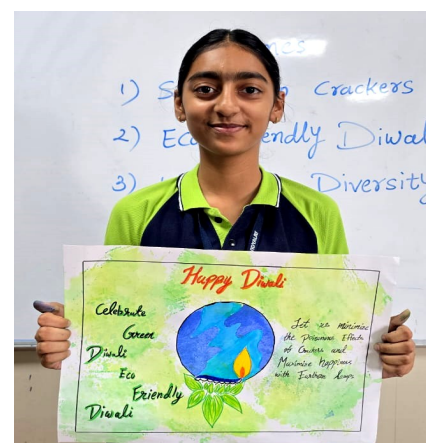
Thematic Poster (Grade 9)
