



Flipped Classroom Training

Venue: Avalon World School, Waghodia - Vadodara



A professional training session on the **Flipped Classroom** approach was successfully conducted at **Avalon World School**, Waghodia, on 15 November 2025. The programme was organized with the objective of equipping teachers with innovative and learner-centred teaching strategies to enhance student engagement and improve learning outcomes.

The workshop was graced by the esteemed presence of Mr. R. K. Sakiya, Principal, Avalon World School; Mr. Sanjay Singh, Principal, DPS Harni; and Mr. Shyam Babu Shukla, Principal, Ambe School, whose encouragement added value to the event.

The session was led by the resource person, Ms. Sakshi Sharma, who introduced the concept of the flipped classroom model. She explained that in this approach, students are first exposed to new concepts at home through short videos or reading materials, while classroom time is utilized for discussions, doubt clarification, problem-solving, and interactive activities. This method effectively transforms the classroom from a teacher-centred setup to a student-centred learning environment.

During the training, teachers were guided on designing effective pre-class tasks and planning meaningful in-class activities. Practical demonstrations, interactive discussions, and collaborative activities enabled participants to understand the application of the flipped classroom model across different subjects. The session also highlighted how this approach supports slow learners, encourages active participation and enhances overall classroom interaction.

The training programme was informative, well-structured, and highly engaging. It inspired teachers to adopt modern pedagogical practices in their daily teaching. The session concluded with the shared understanding that the flipped classroom technique, when implemented thoughtfully and consistently, can significantly enrich the teaching-learning process.

Olympiad Examination Std (3 to 12)

Venue: Atmiya Vidyalay, Manjalpur - Vadodara

The Olympiad examinations were conducted in a well-planned manner with Social Science (ISSO) held on 11 November 2025, followed by the STEM Innovation Olympiad on 12 November 2025 and English (IOEL) on 13 November 2025. The Science Olympiad (IOS) was conducted on 18 November 2025, and the series concluded with the Mathematics Olympiad (IOM) on 19 November 2025.



Learning Outcomes of Olympiad

1. Technological Awareness:

After appearing for the STEM Innovation Olympiad (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) students significantly enhanced their competencies in scientific reasoning, analytical thinking, computational skills, engineering perspective, creative problem-solving, and technological awareness. The exposure to multi-concept questions helped them develop precision, logical sequencing, observation skills, and the confidence to attempt higher-order challenges in the future.

2. Promoting Logical Thinking and Reasoning:

The International Olympiad of Mathematics (IOM) enhances students' logical thinking and reasoning skills. By making mathematics and other disciplines engaging and enjoyable, the platform significantly boosts students' mental abilities and motivates them.

3. Socio-Cultural Awareness

The Social Science (iSSO) Olympiad was conducted with the objective of deepening students' understanding of history, civics, geography, and economics through engaging and thought-provoking assessment.

Through the Social Science Olympiad, students developed critical thinking, map-reading skills, decision-making, and comparative analysis. The exam also strengthened their abilities in interpretation of historical sources, understanding governance processes, evaluating global issues, and forming logical conclusions. This helped nurture informed, responsible, and thoughtful young citizens.



4. Knowledge Testing

The International Olympiad of English Language (iOEL) provides students with a unique opportunity to test the knowledge they have acquired over the years and assess their academic standing among peers.



5. Preparation for Competitive Exams:

The International Olympiad of Science (iOS) equips students with the skills necessary for preparing for highly competitive exams such as NEET, JEE and CETs. It also helps develop scientific aptitude and problem-solving skills.



From the school, **535** students from classes I to XII across Science and Commerce streams actively participated in various Olympiad disciplines. This eager response reflects the effective utilization of the platform to prepare students for international-level Competition.



Show and Tell Competition (KG - Section)

Venue: Atmiya Vidyalay, Manjalpur - Vadodara



The students of Atmiya Vidyalaya celebrated SHOW AND TELL COMPETITION this year with great enthusiasm on the 29TH NOVEMBER, 2025.

The aim of this competition was to encourage young learners to develop confidence and enhance their speaking skills. The event was conducted in the school corridor, where Nursery, Junior Kg, and Senior Kg students participated enthusiastically.



The main objective of the competition was to help children express their thoughts clearly, improve their vocabulary and overcome stage fear. Students came dressed up as doctors, pilots, soldiers, milkman and other community helpers along with their related props.



The program begun with the daily prayer performed by Junior Kg Teachers. The entire atmosphere became devotional. After the prayer, our tiny tots started performing their chosen roles, and one by one all the participants from each class joined in. They presented their roles with bright smiles and great excitement. Each child spoke a few sentences about their chosen objects. SAFAL Examination Std (6 & 9)

Venue: Atmiya Vidyalay, Manjalpur - Vadodara

The CBSE SAFAL (Structured Assessment for Analyzing Learning) Examination was conducted for **Classes 6 and 9** as per the schedule prescribed by CBSE. The assessment for **Class 9** was held on **11th, 12th and 17th November**, while **Class 6** students appeared for the examination on **24th and 26th November**. The exam aimed to assess students' competency levels in core subjects and support improved learning outcomes through diagnostic evaluation.



SAFAL (Structured Assessment for Analyzing Learning), launched by the Central Board of Secondary Education in July 2021, is a competency-based diagnostic assessment aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. This year, Key Stage Assessment (KSA) was conducted on the mentioned priorly-intimated dates to the parents and students, for Classes 6 and 9 in the subjects of Language, Mathematics and Science, under the directions of CBSE.



The SAFAL assessment serves as a valuable tool for schools and teachers to understand the existing competency levels of learners. By identifying strengths and areas needing improvement, it enables enhanced instructional planning and targeted academic support. For students of Classes 6 and 9, the assessment proved highly fruitful, emphasising on deeper conceptual understanding, problem-solving abilities and subject-wise clarity. SAFAL continues to play a vital role in strengthening learning outcomes and developing essential competencies among students.



Khel Mahakumbh 2025–26

Venue: Manjalpur & Wadhodiya Sports Complex

Atmiya Vidyalay proudly participated in Khel Mahakumbh 2025–26, where students demonstrated remarkable enthusiasm, dedication, and sportsmanship.
